'Excellent': 5 votes

'Good': 2 votes

- Stunning images from the telescopes and interesting account of the Mothers' continuing quest for the Disappeared. However, I thought, at times, the Director struggled to tie the two halves of the documentary together.
- A beautifully filmed & poetic documentary. However, quite difficult to watch the unrelenting search for bodies.

'Satisfactory': 3 votes

- Beautifully filmed but a bit pretentious and disengaging. I do think, however, that bastard Jack Straw should be made to watch it.
- Interesting in some parts but dull in others.
